The agenda items were taken up for discussion and following decisions were made.

Computer Engineering - M. Tech. in Computer Engineering, M. Tech. in Information Security

 Electronics & Communication Engineering - M. Tech. in Embedded Systems. M. Tech. in Wireless Communications System Design and Management

· Architecture -M Arch. in Urban Planning

It was agreed that two of the programmes _ M. Tech. (Computer Engineering) and M. Planning (Urban Planning) will start from the academic session 2008-09. The detailed scheme and syllabus of these programmes be updated according to Senate guidelines.

For remaining two M. Tech. programmes - Embedded Systems and Wireless Communications System Design & Management, the Department of Electronics & Comm. Engineering, will adapt the contents of the proposed specialization and emphasize the same into their existing M. Tech. programmes - VLSI Design & Electronics & Communication Engineering, respectively.

Item No. 13-4.4(a) To consider waiving course requirement for completing Pre-Ph.D. courses for internal senior faculty members pursuing Ph.D.

On the proposal of Director the senate has agreed and resolved that for a senior internal faculty member having experience of 8 years or more, the requirement of Pre-Ph.D. courses will be waived if someone would register for Ph.D.

(b) To consider relaxing count of slots for Ph.D. supervisors guiding internal faculty members

The suggestion of Director, to relax the limit on slots for supervising Ph.D. candidates if a faculty member of MNIT registers for Ph.D. and the slot restriction becomes effective, was appreciated and accepted.

On 3rd April 2008 the meeting continued till 06.50 P.M. The meeting was reconvened on 24th April 2008.

Prof. R. P. Dahiya, Director, MNIT and Chairman, Senate chaired the meeting and welcomed the Senators. The agenda items were taken up for discussion and following decisions were made:

The Director proposed that the students residing in hostels should be allowed to use desert coolers in their rooms. The proposal was discussed and it was resolved that the students will be charged Rs. 350/- per month to be paid in advance for one session to meet electricity and water charges. For the month of May 2008, however, the charges shall be half since the end term examination will be over and the majority of the hostellers will leave the hostels by 10th May 2008. The Dean, Students Affairs and Wardens should circulate the decision for information of the students and are requested to implement the decision.
